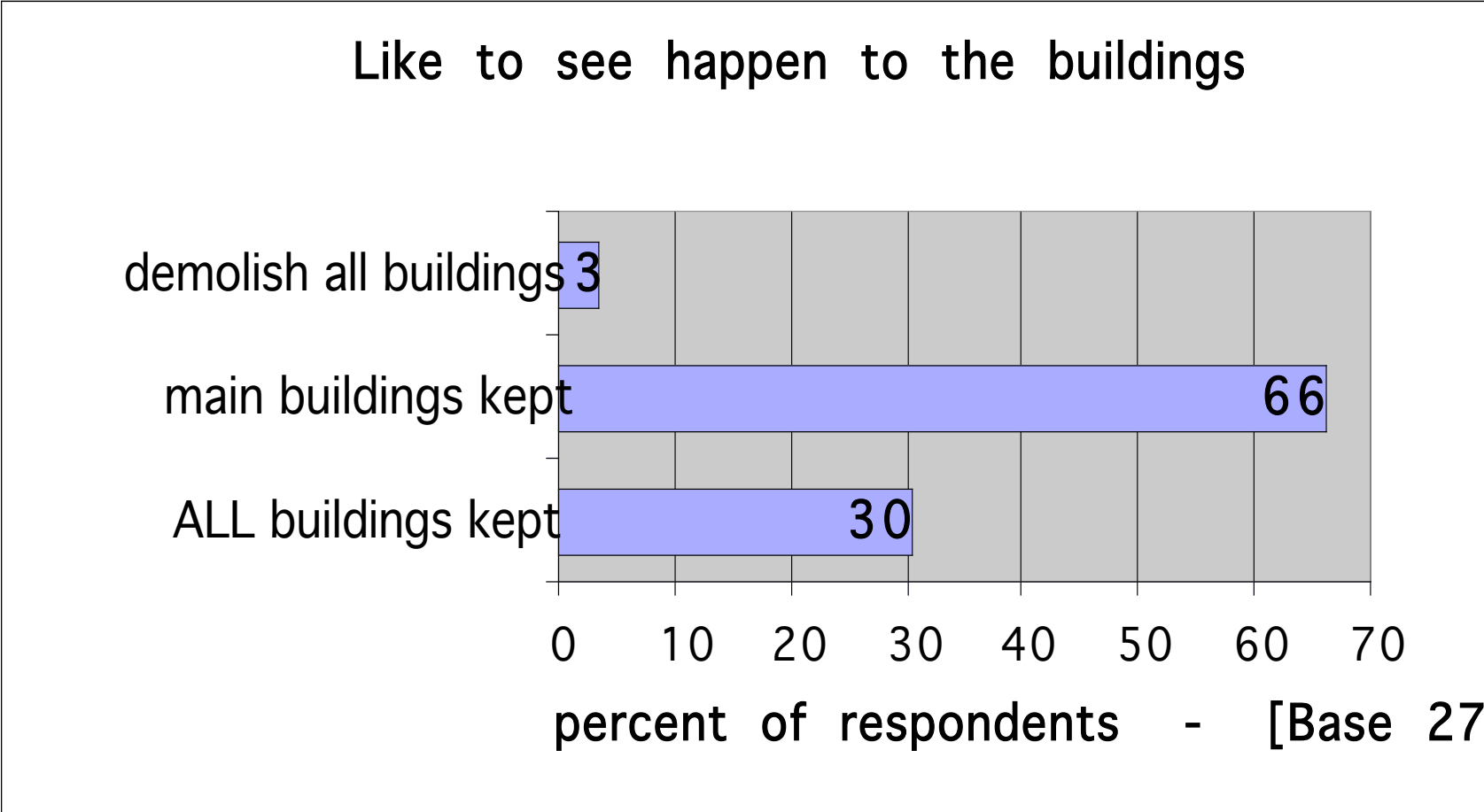

Respondents

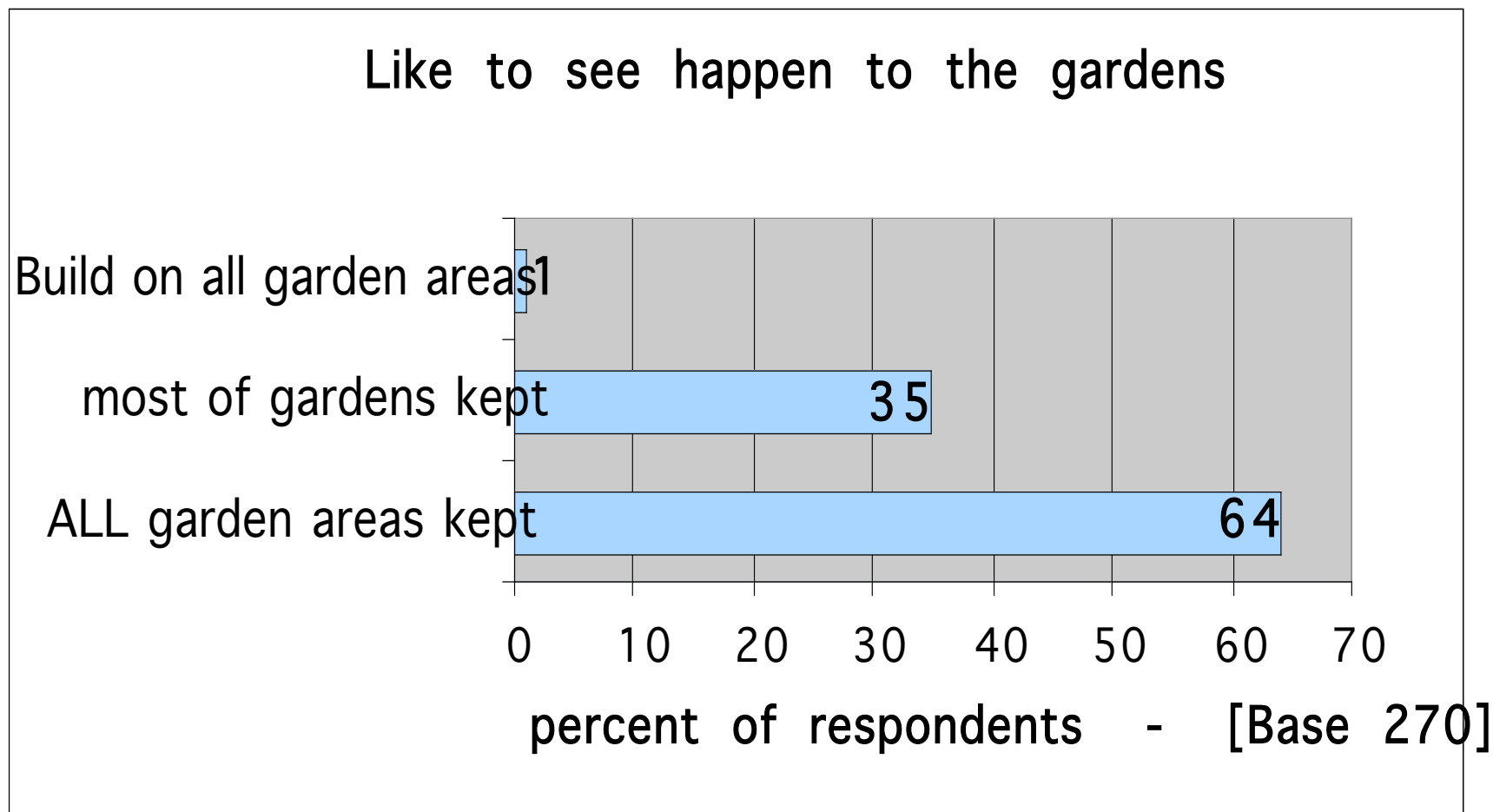
The majority of respondents live in postal areas

- BN1 3F (Wykeham Terrace, Victoria Road, Victoria Street, St Michael's Place)

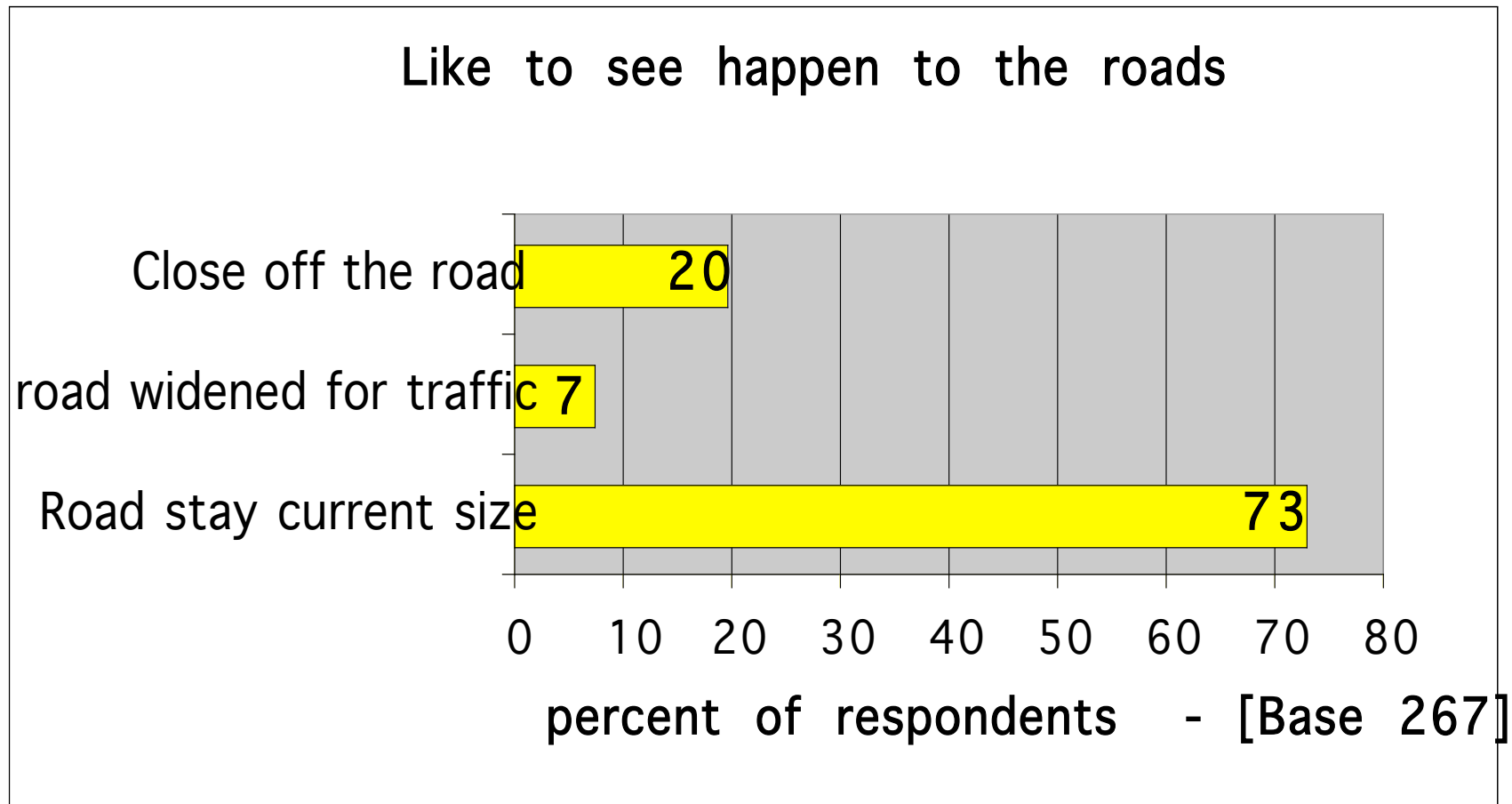
Nearly all respondents (97%) would like to see at least some of the original buildings kept.



Nearly all respondents (99%) would like to see at least most of the gardens kept.

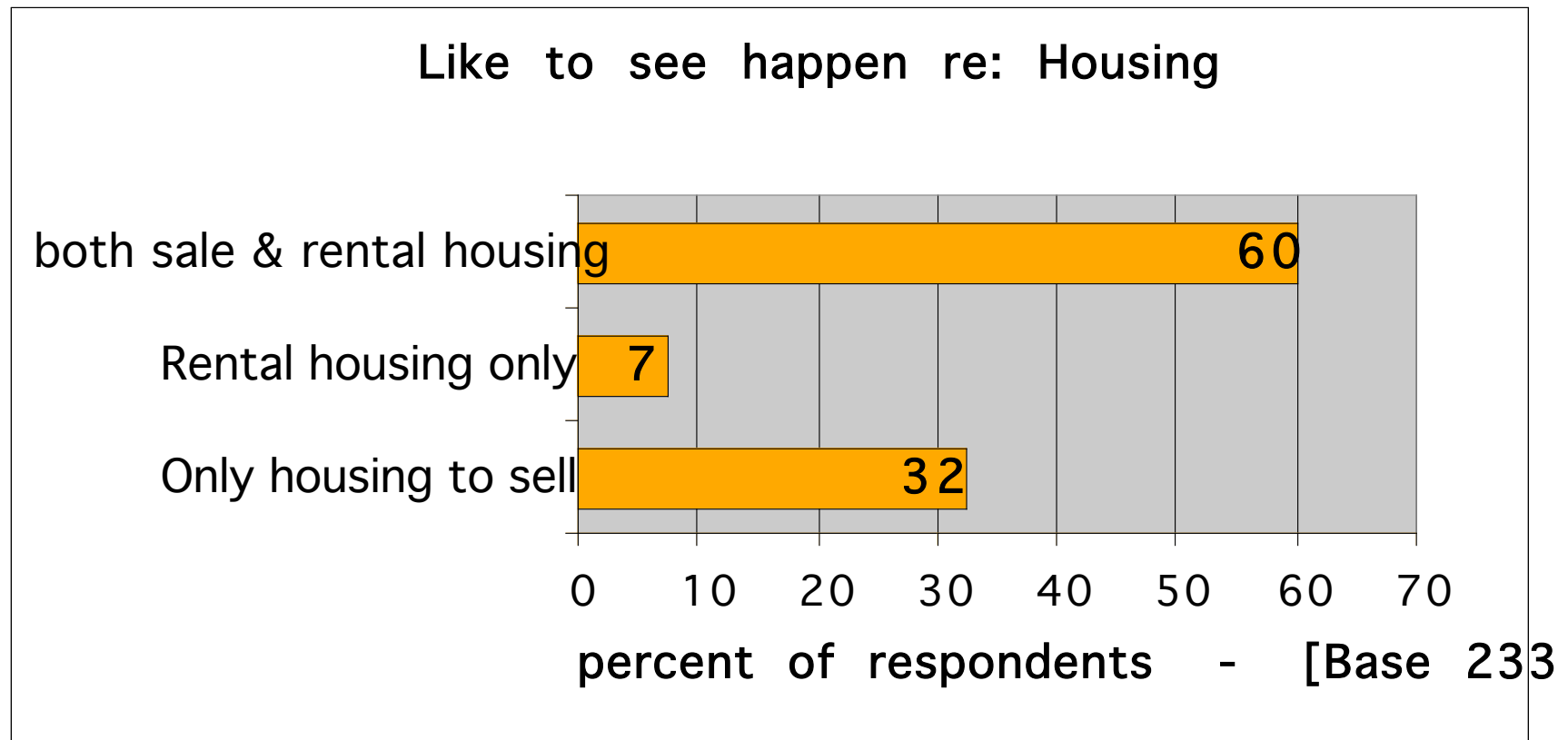


Three-quarters of respondents would like to see the road (Clifton Hill) stay at it current size

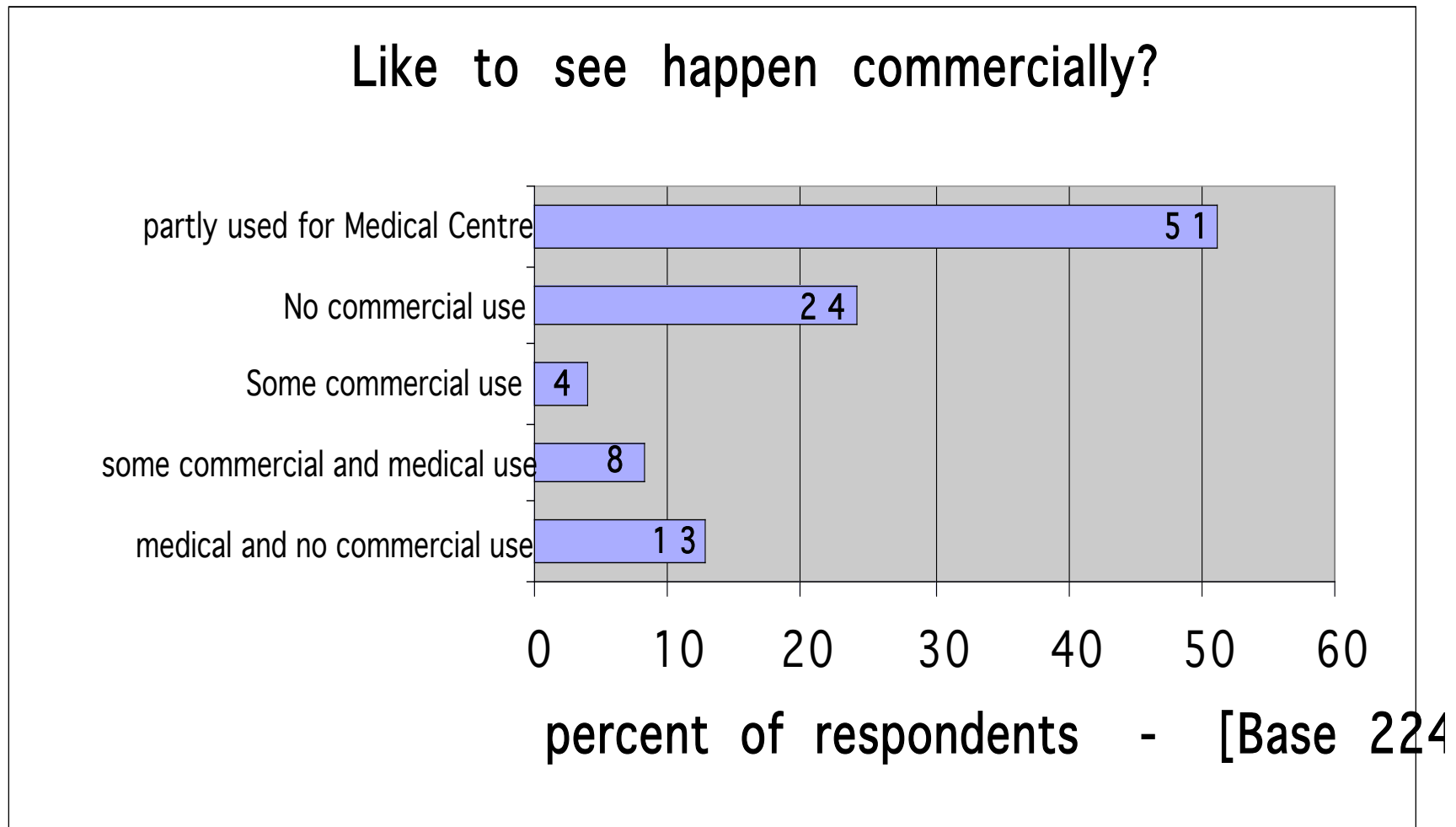


The majority of respondents (60%) would like to see a mixture of both sale and rental housing.

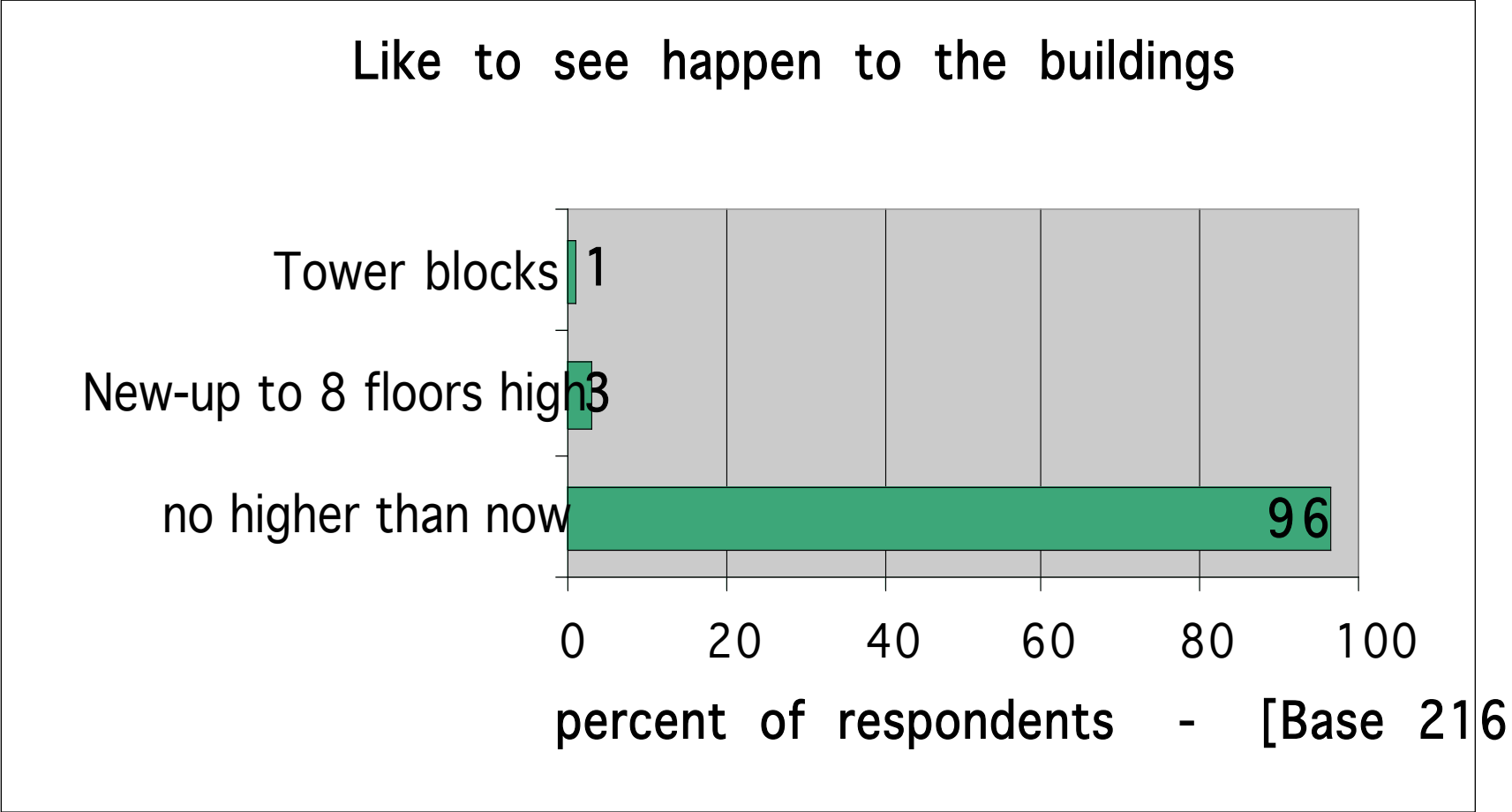
Over nine out of ten respondent (92%) would like to see housing for sale, and over two thirds (67%) to see housing for rent.
