

Say NO to Mitre House

Two storeys more is too high



Mitre House is already the tallest building in Western Road. Raising it from six to eight storeys will cast a shadow up to 100 metres long and rob a huge chunk of central Brighton of its classic sea views



Mitre House occupies the entire block between Hampton Place and Spring Street. In winter its shadow will stretch beyond Upper North Street

It will destroy the classic view of the sea down Victoria Street

Housing for 130 students will create noise and disturbance and extra traffic

Students' roof terrace will be a site for parties as well as overlooking neighbouring gardens
